#### **CHURCH CANCELLED**

Due to the stay-at-home order from Johnson County, we have extended our cancellation of all services and Sunday school until Sunday, April 26th.



Dear Friends, As I write this, it is Thursday, April 9th. It has been one month since we started

practicing physical distancing, including avoiding gatherings and isolating in our homes. For all of us, the world has changed in great and small ways. From restaurants not being open, to one way aisles at the grocery store, a limit of one person per household allowed in stores, masks and gloves being worn in public, and a general ban on all gatherings greater than ten people. It is awe-inspiring how different the world is in one month.

Things no longer feel the same, and they are not. Yesterday, Allen Watts and Emily Yeh and I met to record an Easter service to put on the church YouTube and Facebook pages. There will be no Easter worship in-person Sunday. From the safety of our homes we will watch and join in worship on our screens. Many will say, "it doesn't feel like Easter". And they are right, it

doesn't. But that doesn't change the fact that it IS Easter.

Our current dilemma, this current crisis, can not stop Easter from coming. No more than the Roman soldiers stationed to guard the tomb 2000 years ago could stop Easter from coming. No more than the disciples fear-filled huddles behind closed doors scared for their lives could stop Easter from coming. No, this Sunday, Easter comes to us wherever we find ourselves. This Sunday the dawn breaks, no matter how dark the night might seem. This Sunday the sun rises no matter how many clouds might be in the sky. If able, make time, Easter morning to watch and engage in the Easter service online. Make this Sunday feel like Easter, because it is Easter. Jesus has risen! He has risen indeed!





# Your options of how you may give your tithes and offerings during the "Stay-at-Home" Order.

Merriam Christian Church now provides a number of ways to give.

Write a check. Since we are not able to place CHECKS in the offering plate during worship at this time you can still mail it the church or DROP-BY the church and place it in the mail box

Have funds *automatically withdrawn* from your bank check or savings account or one-time special donations can be made. Go to: <a href="http://www.easytithe.com/merriamce">http://www.easytithe.com/merriamce</a> to set up your account. Or go to the church website and click on the new giving buttons:

With the "auto giving" option you will be able to designate the amount and the timing of your giving – a specific date each month, weekly, bi-weekly, monthly, twice a month, quarterly and annually. You can also designate a credit or debit card versus a checking or savings account.







#### Text giving: 913-444-6397 through your smart phones

Merriam Christian Church's (SMS) Text Giving Account has been set up. Our account Number is: 913-444-6397. Members of the congregation or visitors can simply text an amount to that number to get started. The first time you give by this method there is a quick form to fill out on line. Any subsequent giving actions will not require the form to be filled out again.

**Download the easyTithe app on your smart phone** and make a donation, using your debit or credit card, by selecting **Merriam Christian Church** from the drop down list.


