Lent is upon us once again. Lent begins Wednesday February 17th with

Ash Wednesday and constitutes a 40-day-journey through Easter Sunday, April 4th. 

distance. We will also live stream the service for those at home.





SUNDAY SCHOOL CLASS

Jim Owens is interested in starting up a temporary Sunday school class for those interested. He is proposing the following:

1. Restart Sunday school class.

A. Restart beginning March 7th.

- (1) Due to Pandemic there would be one Adult Class.
- a. Hold class in Fellowship Hall as our classrooms do not provide for spacing.
- b. Combine zoom with class for those wanting a class but not come to church.
- c. Begin class at 9 a.m. until 9:45 a.m. and then go to church at 10:00 a.m.
- d. Several teachers could rotate i.e. teach 3-4 Sundays and then trade off.
- 2. March 1st would give time to order teaching and student books.
- (1) We would need to use one selection of materials and need time to assess this with students and teachers.
- a. Offer your suggestion for type of lesson desired, i.e. Standard Bible Study, Discussion Type, topical, etc.
- b. Those volunteering to teach would make final decisions on material. If you are interested in teaching but need to stay home, we could arrange teaching via zoom, just let us know.
- 3. Mark Willis and Allen Watts have indicated they would assist with Zoom set-up, etc.


Pastor Mark's **Prayerful Meditation**mid-week video (2/11)







Vaccination plans for the week of Feb. 8:

Health care workers – JCDHE reached out to 6,891 people whose second doses are due for appointments this week. Appointments are being scheduled via a unique link. We will be reaching out to those due for their second doses after Feb. 12 soon.

80+ population - The county will continue vaccinating persons in this category. The majority of those contacted are being vaccinated at clinics next week on Wednesday and Thursday. Please complete the interest form. Those who have successfully completed the county's interest form and have not been vaccinated will receive a follow-up email or phone call from the county on how to book an appointment. We are regularly monitoring our data to ensure that everyone who takes this survey is being contacted when they are eligible for an appointment.

65+ population - Johnson County hospital systems – AdventHealth, Menorah Medical Center, Overland Park Regional, Olathe Health, KU Med, St. Luke's Hospital are beginning vaccinations. Go to their websites for more information.

K-12 public and private school staff and daycare providers will be vaccinated through Children's Mercy at various locations. Eligible staff should receive information from their school or district administration. Saturday, Feb. 13 will be a clinic for daycare center staff and home child care providers who completed the <u>county's interest survey</u>.

First responders (fire, police and Sheriff's Office) – The last clinic for this group was held on Monday.

Anyone in the Tier 1 categories who missed their dose – These individuals can make an appointment at any available vaccination clinic.

At vaccination clinics, we continue to have warming buses, parking lot transportation and a front door drop off area for those who feel comfortable coming to a clinic in the inclement weather. However, if you and your family chose not to venture out, you may reschedule or cancel you appointment through a link in the confirmation email you received when you completed our survey. If you choose to cancel or reschedule and new appointments aren't yet available, please check the link later this week or next week.
