Dear Friends, I know these past months have been difficult. I know they have been full of hard decisions and stressful situations. I have tried

to listen to all of the feedback given through phone calls, emails, and leadership Zoom meetings. I have heard your opinions and perspectives and have tried to be respectful of all views in this matter. I have tried to take into account the guidelines of expert medical and scientific organizations, the advice of our Regional and General Church leadership, and the accounts of other pastors and churches going through this same moment. It has all resulted in the following:

Merriam Christian Church will re-open for in-place worship on Sunday June 21, 2020. We will do one worship service at 10AM. We will continue to stream the worship service and provide an online viewing.

Our primary precaution taken will be physical distance. Everyone not in the same household/family will need to maintain six-feet of separation, at all times. One person at a time can use the elevator. We will have a volunteer stationed there to press buttons and send/retrieve the elevator. In the sanctuary, we ask that you sit with your family at a spot marked by blue tape.

We strongly encourage everyone over the age of 18 to wear masks, for the protection of others in attendance. This falls in our Christian prerogative to serve one another. We will have masks, gloves, and hand sanitizer available.

Communion will be set out individually on the table so that at the end of the service as we process out, we can take communion, dispose of the cups and exit. An offering basket will be set up to drop offering/tithes into while entering/exiting.

We will **not** hand out bulletins. Bob Pape and Allen Watts have been working hard to install a projector and screen, so the entire worship service order and selections can be displayed during worship for all to see.

At this time, after reviewing information from studies and the American Choral Directors Association, we will have singing. It is our hope that the physical distancing will be adequate protection.

We will **not** have the nursery or Children's Worship right now. Children that come will sit with their families. Sunday school classes will not meet in June and we will not have Fellowship Cookie Hour at this time. If the next two weeks go well, **we will start our small groups in July**, like Sunday school, DWM, and Our Gang, if these groups want to meet. They will be asked to keep physically distant, and encouraged to wear masks.

I have tried to listen to everyone and incorporate safe, common procedures that can move us to being together again. As you read this over, please be in daily prayer for Merriam Christian Church, our members, and our leadership as we move forward together in this moment.

If you have any questions, let me know. I look forward to being together physically again for worship and continuing to worship online with those who cannot come back at this time. God Bless and Stay Safe.

Mark described re-opening procedures, most of which were detailed to leadership two weeks ago in email. A letter will be sent to the congregation detailing procedures and processes.



Joel Beaver presented sign replacement details. An email had been sent out prior to the meeting to trustees, elders, deacons and committee chairs with all the details and information on six different options and bids - Joel covered all of them in detail.

House and Grounds recommends option 2 (\$21,000 total, with \$11,751 from insurance, \$5,200 from memorial, and remaining \$4,048 needed from church). We will open up to donations as well.

House and Grounds makes a motion we go with Option #2. Motion passed by those present on call.

Regional DWM has asked to hold a meeting July 11th for 20 people - leadership agreed.

Blood drive moved to August 10, 2020 per Pat Reed

Sign Replacement Approved by the Church Board!



House & Grounds evaluated 6 proposals and recommended the sign shown above, option #2. The designs were discussed. Option 2 was approved by the church board which will cost \$21,000 total with \$11,751 covered by the insurance settlement and \$5,200 from memorial funds which will leave a balance of \$4,048 to come from church funds. 
