Dear Friends, On Facebook yesterday, Rev. Lara Blackwood-Pickrel, from

Smithville Christian Church, shared a memory from 2014 when I keynoted at our High School church camp at Tall Oaks. Ι brought a message about "BE"ing the church to a new generation. In it Ι quote a fantastic poem by an author that has escaped my recollection. It was a poem that encouraged people to strive to BE what they were passionate about being: "I don't want to be the fireman, I want to be the fire! Full of passion and heat!"

In the sermon, I moved from quoting his poem to encouraging these young people to BE more than we, the previous generation had been. We had sought to be Christians, to be Disciples, to be the church, but I called them to BE more. As the sermon came to an end, I implored them: "I don't want you to be Christians. I want you to be grace. I want you to be forgiveness. I want you to be redemption.

I don't want you to be Disciples. I want you to be love. I want you to be compassion. I want you to be justice.

I don't want you to be Church. I want you to be praise. I want you to be prayer. I want you to be communion, broken and shared.

If you can figure out how to be these things, we'll all be one step closer to being the Body of Christ." Seven years later, as Rev. Lara posted this memory, I went back and re-read that sermon. It is one that I love dearly, and in retrospect I humbly offer, it will still preach.
