to announce we

will re-open for in-person worship on June 21, 2020. There will be ONE worship service at 10AM. We WILL continue to stream the worship service for all who wish to participate from home. There will be no Sunday school or fellowship cookie hour at first. We will need to maintain physical distance of six feet from anyone not in your household at all times. We are hoping we can recommend but not require masks, and we are hoping we can sing during service. We are waiting until June 16th to make these final adjustments to gather as much data/information as possible.

It will be different then what we used to have. In time we hope we can slowly adjust and reintroduce familiar pieces back into worship. But for now, we will not pass anything. In lieu of a bulletin, we will utilize a projector and screen. We will sit six feet apart (You can of course sit with your family unit). For the offering we will have a basket on the communion table to drop your tithe/offering in upon entering or leaving worship. Communion will be placed

on the table, and you will be able to individually partake as we end worship. This is where we will start. With time and information, we will adjust as we can moving forward. We hope to begin small groups, like Sunday School, DWM, and Our Gang in July, following the same precautions. If all goes well we will look to opening back up for our outside groups, with precautions, in August. I know this is a slow process, but we are trying to respect everyone's concerns and input. Please be graceful and patient as we walk this path together. If you are not feeling well, have a fever, or a cough, we must insist you stay home and seek medical care. If you are in a high risk category, including being over 65, having underlying health issues like diabetes, high blood pressure, cancer, etc. or If you would rather stay home to feel safer right now, the worship service WILL be online. Please be in prayer as we take this first step back together again physically. Please be in prayer for our leadership as we navigate these unknown waters. Please be in prayer for all who come to gather that they be safe, and for all who continue to worship from home, that they be watched over. And please be in prayer for me, as your pastor, that God lead and guide us through this time. I am looking forward to seeing you again in person! God Bless, Mark

# **Status of Church Sign**




