

**Outreach:** Pam-During the last committee meeting, the Helping Hands Food Pantry was discussed and what it would look like and how to promote. Until this is onsite, we want to support local food pantries such as Shawnee Community Services with toiletries, pancake mix, syrup, pasta & sauce, peanut butter, jelly, canned tuna, boxed cereals, rice and canned fruits and vegetables. Also continuing to collect bottled water. Prepared and packed 150 meals on 3/30 for JoCo Food Ministry. Thanks to all who provided cookies and helped with the meals. Contacted Rachel at Merriam Park Elementary to see if there is a need for "catch-up" on lunch tickets, waiting on answer. Rachel is contacting families who receive BackSnacks to make sure they are aware of the summer food resources. Our BackSnack program and Meals on Wheels deliveries continue on a regular basis.

### ADULT SUNDAY SCHOOL CLASS


Our Sunday School class meets from 9:00 -9:45 each Sunday. Following our class time we have a 15 minute break to prepare for Morning Worship at 10:00.
