Baptism and Confirmation Class is open to anyone who would like to give their life to Jesus Christ and be baptized. It is also open to those who have been baptized as infants, but would like to Confirm the baptism their parents gave them.

Baptism is the outward sign of an inward change, meaning when a person is ready to accept Jesus Christ into their hearts, they step forward into the waters of baptism.
