Twelve-and-a-halfyears ago I was called here to Merriam Christian Church to be your pastor. I was getting out of a children's

ministry position that wasn't working out as I had hoped. I was wanting to get back into weekly preaching and serving and when I met the folks at Merriam, I knew I had found the church I needed.

Over the past decade-plus we have strived to live our faith together, through grace and mission. We have gone into our community to feed people, to help where we could help, and to be a living presence of the Body of Christ. We have gathered for worship and praise, for study and prayer, and for fellowship moments that bind us together as a church. I have loved my time here at Merriam, and have been touched and changed by the people, the ministries, and the time we have spent together. Much has changed during this journey, and the last two years alone have presented us with new challenges and obstacles. And now it must change again.

This past month, I informed the Board that I would be resigning my position as Pastor for Merriam Christian Church effective Sunday, July 17, 2022. I have accepted a call to be minister for North Oak Christian Church in the northland and will begin there on August 1st.. This is a new opportunity for me to work with that congregation, who are eager to get out and be a presence of the Body of Christ in their community. It is also an opportunity for Merriam Christian Church to evaluate where they are, what they are blessed with, and where God is calling them anew.

I have been overwhelmingly blessed to be your pastor these past years, and I am grateful for each of you. You have blessed me in more ways than I can describe. Your kindness, generosity, and grace have filled my spirit time and again. I know that God is with you on this path, and will guide you to what comes next.

Over the next month, I will be working with our leadership here to begin setting up this transition. I will hand over my responsibilities and help our leadership to connect with our Regional church to enter into the interim process. Please be in prayer for Merriam Christian Church, for our leaders and and our congregation as they seek out where God is calling the church today. Be in prayer that God will send an interim minister who can help the church to ask hard questions and seek good solutions to move forward. And lastly, please keep me in your prayers as I seek to serve in this new calling.

Mike called the meeting to order.

Devotions: Pat Reed-God on All Sides

Minutes of 5/10/22 Board Meeting: Mike asked the board to review the minutes; Motion to accept report by Michelle Land; seconded by Greg Spiegel; board vote, approved.

Current Financial Report: Mike asked the board to review the current financial report; Motion to accept report by Rick Ferguson; seconded by Greg Spiegel; board vote, approved.

Committee Chair Reports:

Clerk: Betty-Opal Wylie passed away on May 2, 2022. Frank and Opal joined the church in November 1970. Frank passed away June 2014. Total membership is 142.

DWM: No report.

Elders: No report.

H&G: Joel-The flat roof at the North end of the church is leaking & water is running down the bricks and into the plaster at the top of the steps. We have received bids to make the necessary repairs. We have selected Badger Roofing to recaulk all around the flat roof and drains. He is a week to ten days out. We are getting bids for sidewalk replacement, asphalt work and resealing the parking lot. We had another water issue in the church basement. Bob and I cleaned up 2-3 inches of water and got it dried. Bob found the sump pump was not working as the breaker had tripped. We have no idea why it tripped, but the pump is working fine. The oldest air conditioning unit (number 3) was not working and Bob found the A-coil was a block of ice. I called McCarty for service/repair. Sherri with McCarty will contact me with a date. Meanwhile, any activities in the classrooms may need to move to Campbell Hall or the Library until the A/C is fixed.

Outreach: Pam-Merriam Park Elementary School does not have need from us for food in their summer program; Free Hot Soup continues to need bottled water. The next Johnson County Food Ministry is June 30. Food will be cooked on-site and packaged for pick-up.

Membership: Jeannette-Committee will be giving Father's Day donuts to all dads at service on Sunday June 19. We will be hosting Sunday Coffee Hour on July 10 and are starting to plan a barbeque in August or September at the church. **Memorial:** No report.

Pastoral Relations: No report.

Pastor's Report: Pastor Mark-Carole Prentice and Betty Bohn and I discussed the funeral meals and how we might continue to serve in this area for members and friends of MCC. Carole was willing to lead this ministry and organize our meal offerings. We discussed the board establishing this as a committee with a budget. Others at MCC, like DWM, can contribute as they see fit, whether monetarily or with food and service. Donations from families would go to future meals. We will discuss this further at the board meeting in July. We are continuing to work with Webdeb Sites, the company that maintains our current website, on updating our website. I have fallen woefully behind on this but am hoping to find some time this month to get this done.

I performed seven funerals and five wedding this month.

Regional Report-Pastor Mark-I continue to serve with our Regional Board as Secretary and am involved in ongoing discussions about the future of Tall Oaks campsite. We are examining and exploring the current state of Tall Oaks, what it will take to get it solvent and what options are available moving forward. These conversations are ongoing, and are considering all possible options and outcomes. There will be listening sessions set up in the coming weeks for people to hear and discuss these options, with a set goal of making a regional decision at the September Regional Board Meeting.

Personnel: No report.

Trustees: No report.

Worship: Pastor Mark-Committee met and discussed upcoming events. Pentecost started June 5th. We will keep the red paraments up until July 3rd. That week I will meet with Bob & Rick to change the colors to green for the common season of the liturgy. We are coordinating with membership for Father's Day gifts after worship on June 19. I am looking into using the Narrative Lectionary this summer, which groups lectionary readings in a more narrative structure, allowing for more connected sermons or series. We will start with four-week sermon series on the Ten Commandments. Elders have returned to worship service, offering prayer for the offering & communion. We are still figuring out how to re-introduce deacons into worship as well. Worship Committee will have cookie hour the first Sunday in August.

Old Business:

Michelle-new computer has been purchased for the office and new cord for printer.

Pastor Mark-I have accepted a call to serve as pastor for another Disciples congregation beginning August 1, 2022. As such, I must

resign from servicing Merriam Christian Church as pastor, effective July 17. It has been an honor to serve as pastor here and I love this congregation and the ministry and mission they do.
