Dear Friends, It has been quite a month! In between contracting Covid and having to quarantine, and THEN

cutting off a finger tip while cooking! (They were able to glue it back together) Needless to say, I feel a little discombobulated over the past thirty days. But slowly and surely we are getting back into the swing of things.

There is a lot going on in the church right now. Our Cub Scout and Boy Scout groups have resumed in-person meetings, and our AA group is going strong on Wednesdays. The Johnson County Christmas Bureau is having meetings and training as they prepare for their Christmas shop in December, and the bus company's monthly safety meetings are bringing in lots of folks through our doors. And we are participating in the Johnson County Food ministry and Merriam-Park Community Partner Program again. AND we just started up our Thanksgiving Cornucopia food collection for Merriam-Park and Crestview Elementary families again! AND AND of course our Regional Office ministries and teams are meeting and working hard.

In the midst of all of that, this next Tuesday we begin the installation of our new audio-visual technology for worship. This project will bring a complete new

system for our live streaming, including three new cameras, and a new computer to run the system. Two of the cameras will be mounted on the back wall to give us wide angles of the room, plus close up capabilities from straight onto the chancel. The third camera will be mounted on the east wall toward the front, giving us another angle on the chancel, but also the capability to film straight on to the piano and organ when specials are being done. The computer will include software for putting information on the screen of the livestream, including hymn lyrics, scripture, illustrations for sermons, allowing the folks watching at home to participate more easily.

We will also be getting a new sound board. This sound board will improve our sound quality online, BUT it will also improve the sound quality IN the sanctuary for those gathered in-person. This sound board can be controlled through a tablet or phone, making the job on our AV Teams easier.

We will also get new wireless microphones (2). Recently the channel our old wireless mics are on was opened up by the FCC, meaning we will get more traffic, static and interruptions on that signal. So we needed to move to the new signal for wireless mics. This change will up

date our mics and allow for cleaner, smoother sound from them so everyone, those onsite and those online can hear better. There is slight delay on the two mics, they will be here toward the end of October/beginning of November, but we will continue to use our existing wireless mics until then on the new sound board.

FInally, we will also be getting a new projector and screen for those in the room. This update will be a clearer, more stable, brighter picture, so hymn lyrics, scripture, illustration, etc can be seen easier. I am excited to work with our AV teams to utilize this new tool for worship in new and creative ways. Now, this piece will take a bit longer to install as a part is back ordered right now, part of the global shipping slow downs we have been hearing about. It looks like it will be added to the sanctuary in early December. Until then though we will continue to use our current projector and screen which will be implemented into the new system until the new parts arrive.

With all of this technology, there are of course lots of parts and pieces, cables and connectors, and so on. The install starts Tuesday morning and the first big phase should be done by that Thursday. We are then having a training for AV Teams on Saturday, October 16, and the trainer will be onsite with us Sunday October 17th for worship as we start using the new cameras, sound board and computer system to answer questions and provide support. After that the installers will return to add the mics and projector when they arrive and are available for support and guidance throughout.

Pheww! That is a lot! This has been a huge undertaking, that we have been working on, discussing, re-hashing, and re-discussing since April, but it is finally coming to fruition. I want to thank the Board for their leadership and commitment to this idea and I want to thank all those that contributed to this project. We received donations from several folks, and a grant from our Region, so that no monies needed to come out of the church savings or investments for this project. THANK YOU ALL! I am looking forward to launching this new phase on October 17th and can't wait to see how it might impact our ability to get the Word of God out to more people.

### **ANNUAL CONGREGATIONAL MEETING**



#### **PRAISE:**


